Cambridge Joint Playschemes	Cambridge	£15,000	The project will provide a summer playscheme for up to 101 children aged 4-18yrs with profound to moderate learning disabilities in Cambridgeshire.
Cogwheel Trust	Cambridge	£30,000	This project delivers counselling services for 80 children and young people who are experiencing psychological and behavioural problems.
Peterborough African Community Organisation - PACO	Peterborough	£91,482	This project will offer training and volunteering opportunities in community radio for young people in Peterborough. The project will work with children from refugee and asylum seeker families.

Dial Druglink	St Neots	£89,729	The project will work with 12 -18 year old males to seek to minimise harm from drug and alcohol use and the dangers involved in becoming drawn into illegal drug use and dealing and sexual exploitation.
